Dear Parents/ Caregivers

Thank you for your continued support of Wilson State High School, in particular relating to the current COVID 3 day lock down in Greater Brisbane.

I am pleased to confirm the following advice from Queensland Health - our school will continue to be **open to students for the remainder of the Term (tomorrow and Thursday 1/4)** as all school staff are considered essential workers and classes will operate as usual, including scheduled assessment.

**Students** who have visited Greater Brisbane since the 20 March 2021 **are able to attend**, provided they **are well and have not been at one of the listed venues during the times indicated on the Queensland Health Website** (link below). For students affected by this, please ensure you contact the school so we can accurately account for all students.

Students on-site during this lockdown period are not required to wear face masks but can if this is their preference.

Unfortunately, **Parents/Carers** who have been in the Greater Brisbane area since March 20, are not permitted on school sites and should comply with Queensland Health [Directions](#) in relation to Greater Brisbane Lockdowns.

Please be assured that all staff will continue to take the necessary precautions to ensure the health safety and well-being of students, staff and the broader school community.

We will continue to monitor the situation and will provide you with further updates should the health information change.
